PRODUCT IDENTIFICATION

PRODUCT NAME: COMMERCIAL LAUNDRY BLEACH

MANUFACTURERS DESCRIPTION: Concentrated Commercial Bleach

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: Pale yellow, water thin liquid

INGREDIENTS:

Sodium Hypochlorite	LOW
Sodium Hydroxide	VLOW

Proportion (% weight per weight): VHIGH >60, HIGH 30-60, MED 10-29, LOW 1-9, VLOW <1

HEALTH HAZARD INFORMATION

HEALTH EFFECTS:

SWALLOWED: Can result in severe irritation and corrosion of the mucous membranes of the mouth, throat and gastrointestinal tract with pain, inflammation and vomiting. Systematic effects include fall of blood pressure, delirium and coma.

EYE: A severe eye irritant. Prolonged contamination of eyes can result in permanent injury. Corrosive to eyes; contact can cause corneal burns.

SKIN: Contact will result in moderate irritation. Repeated or prolonged skin contact may lead to irritant contact dermatitis or skin burns.

INHALED: Inhalation of mists or aerosols can produce respiratory irritation followed by pulmonary oedema

FIRST AID

SWALLOWED: Immediately rinse mouth with water. Give water to drink. Do NOT induce vomiting. If vomiting occurs give further water to achieve effective dilution. Seek immediate medical assistance.

EYE: Immediately irrigate with copious quantities of water for at least 15 minutes. Eyelids to be held open. Remove clothing if contaminated and wash skin. Seek immediate medical assistance.

SKIN: Immediately wash contaminated skin with plenty of water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before re-use. If swelling, redness, blistering, or irritation occurs seek medical advice.

INHALED: Remove victim from exposure - avoid becoming a casualty. Remove contaminated clothing and loosen remaining clothing. Allow patient to assume most comfortable position and keep warm. Keep at rest until fully recovered. Seek medical advice if effects persist.

PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

EXPOSURE LIMITS:

VENTILATION: Ensure adequate natural ventilation.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Avoid eye contact and repeated or prolonged skin contact. Wear overalls, chemical goggles and impervious gloves. If risk of inhalation of spray mists exists, wear combined organic vapour respirator. Always wash hands before smoking, eating, drinking or using the toilet. Wash contaminated clothing and other protective equipment before storing or re-using.

FLAMMABILITY: Non combustible.

SAFE HANDLING INFORMATION

STORAGE & TRANSPORT: Store in a cool well-ventilated place out of direct sunlight. Store away from acid, combustible materials and foodstuffs. Containers must be carefully vented to release any pressure build up.

SPILLS & DISPOSAL: Small spills - wash to drain with excess water. Large spills - control using sand or soil, neutralise with sodium metabisulphite or sodium thiosulphate and large access of water, then allow to drain.

FIRE/EXPLOSION HAZARD: Non combustible.
